GETTING READY FOR SPRING

Since we are already into winter and it's a bit late to do anything to protect your home from the hazards of that season, I thought I'd jump ahead a bit to spring. When it looks as though winter is finally coming to an end and warmer weather means you'll be going outside to clear winter debris and get your home ready for spring, make sure you do it safely. This means:

- ★ Wear safety goggles, sturdy shoes and long pants when you are operating lawn mowers and other machinery.
- ★ Protect your hearing when you are operating machinery. If you have to raise your voice to talk to someone who is an arm's length away when operating machinery, the noise level is potentially harmful to your hearing.
- ★ Wear gloves to protect your skin from plants, cuts and other irritations. Remember that the poisonous oil (urshinoil) from poison ivy, poison oak and poison sumac remains toxic even when the plants are dormant in winter and does not evaporate. All parts of the living or dead poison plants, including roots, flowers, or berries, contain the urushiol oil. Be especially careful of dead vines on firewood and leafless vines in the winter. Also, keep in mind that if these plants are burned in an open fire, it is possible to get poison oak or inv systemically by breathing the smeke of


- ★ Read and follow the directions on any chemical or lawn and garden product. - ★ Pay attention to signs of heat-related issues including a high body temperature, headache, dizziness, rapid pulse, nausea or confusion. If you are doing spring cleaning in your house, be careful moving large pieces of furniture or appliances. Be safe using ladders and step stools. Follow the directions on cleaning products and wear
